Bomme le bontate, ditokelo tsa rona di re fa seriti, tlhompheho, botho le boitshepo jwaleka setjhaba le motho ka bomong. Molaetsa wa tokomane ena o hlakile bahaeso wa hore "*batho bohle ba na le ditokelo tse tshwanang kapa ka ho lekana.*" Programme Director, human rights are a set of guarantees that ensure not only living but also those basic conditions to live with dignity as a human being. These sets of rights are designed to protect individuals from the threat to life and human dignity. For a long time we had no cause to celebrate, we had been robbed of our dignity and humanity. Now that the democracy we fought so much hard for, has restored our human dignity we have a cause for celebration.

Never shall we revert back to a state of perpetual violation of human rights and degradation of a human kind, which the Indian thinker and educator Juddi Krishnamurti described as *the clever exploit of the stupid* when he said, "What man has done to man has no limit. He has tortured him, he has burned him, he has killed him, he has exploited him in every possible way – religious, political, economic. This has been the story of man to man; the clever exploit the stupid, the ignorant."

As we celebrate these rights, let us always keep in mind that human rights apply to every human being irrespective of nationality, religion, sex, social status, occupation, wealth, property or any other differentiating ethnic, cultural or social characteristics. In its opening article the Declaration of the Universal Human Rights by the United Nations states, "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood."
